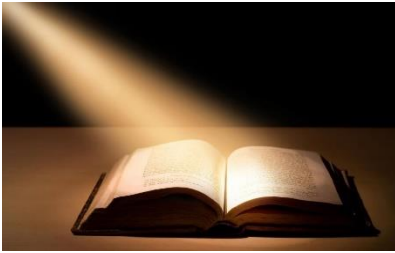

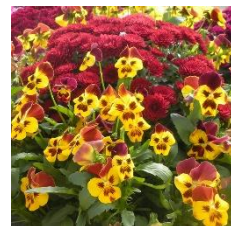
# GIVING GARDEN VOLUNTEERS

There are still LOTS of beautiful flowers blooming in the Bouquet Garden! Come cut a bunch!!!

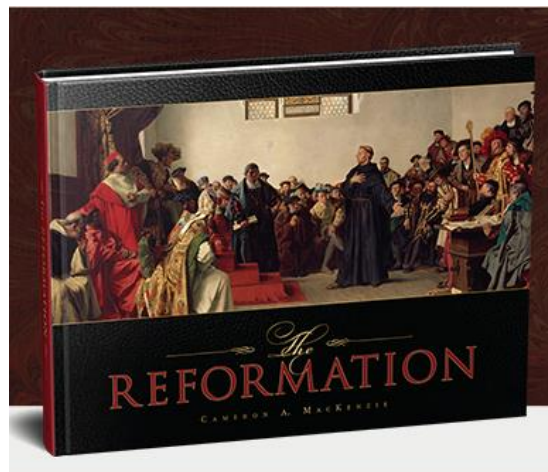

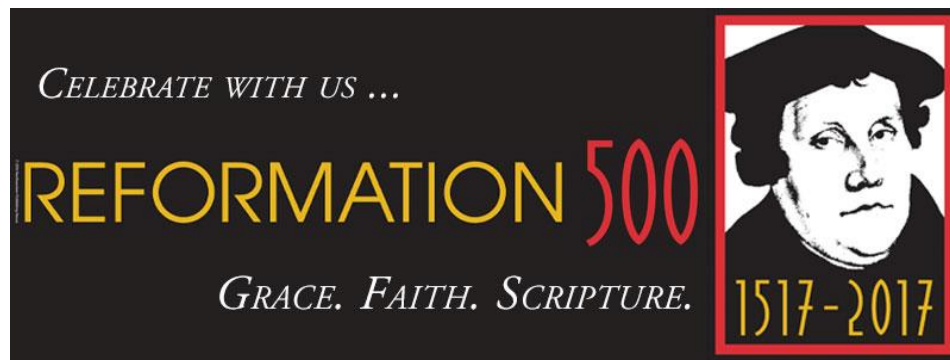


## Artists of the Reformation Era
