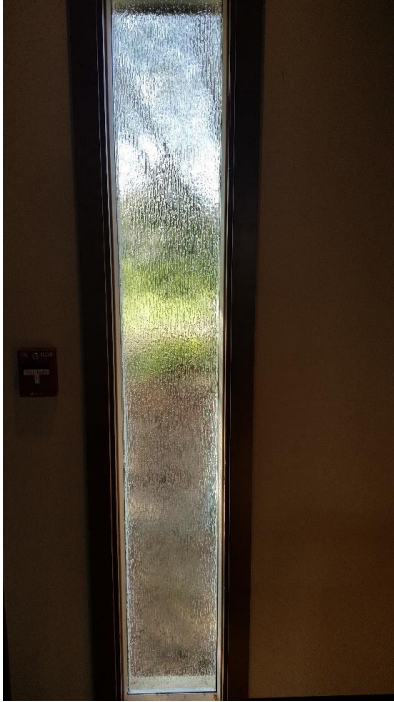

The SVLC Annual Voters' Meeting will be held on Sunday, November 12th following worship. Please plan on attending!

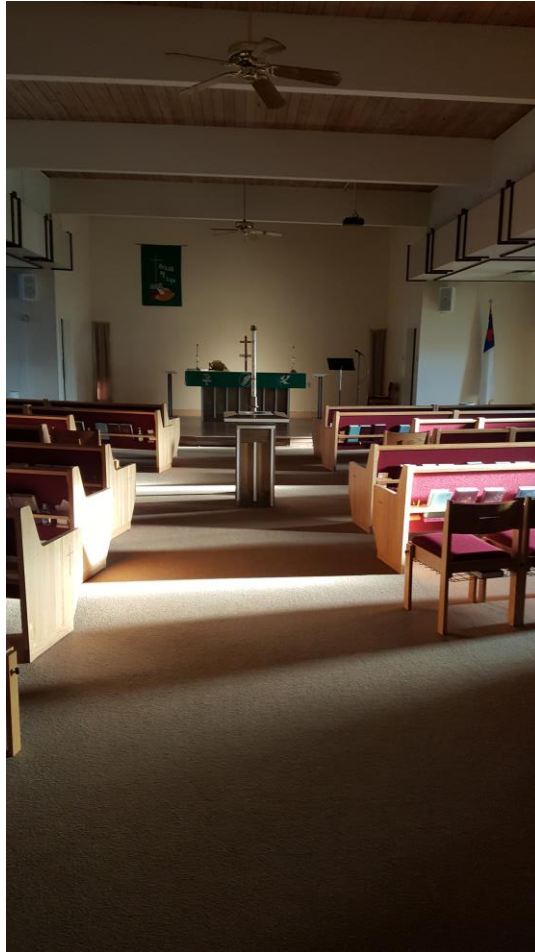

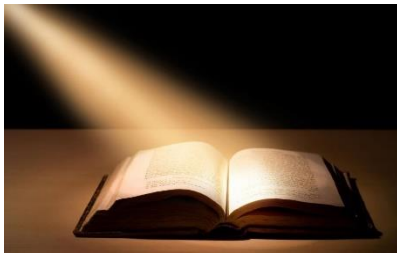


This week . . . we have new windows on the west side of the building! What a difference it makes! These pictures were taken around 5:00 p.m.

Hopefully we'll get some fava beans and radishes sown as cover crops.

Pastor Joel Nickel, artist and theologian

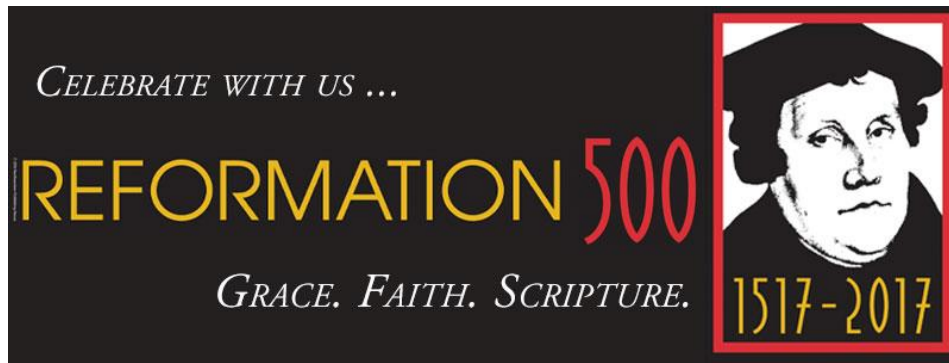
Sunday, October 22nd, 4:00 p.m.
