"Faith groups provide the bulk of disaster recovery".

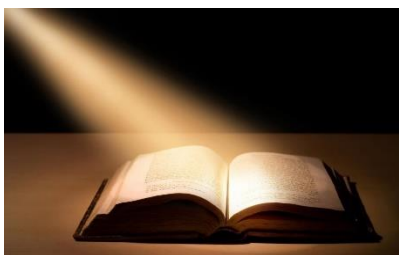

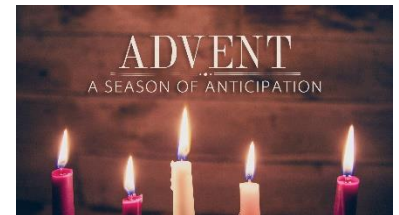
