



New MultiGen+ Sunday Study February 4th – March 25th 10:30-11:30 a.m.

Please join us for an eight-week study led by Pastor Paul Doellinger entitled **Christianity and The Competition**. This video-based series is presented by Dr. Paul L. Maier, who is the Russell H. Seibert Professor of Ancient History at Western Michigan University, the Second Vice-President of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod, and much-published author of both scholarly and popular works.

Christianity and The Competition looks at sacred and secular sources to establish the credentials of Christianity. It goes on to enlighten us about religions of the Far East, the Middle East, Islam, and various Western religions encountered in America today, such as Mormonism, cults, and Scientology. Dr. Maier will take us through a Christian response to the various beliefs and claims of "the competition". Each week we will view video and then enter into a period of discussion. Pr. Paul wanted to share a little TAX TIP FOR THOSE OVER 70 1/2

The tax bill that Congress recently passed has doubled the personal exemption and raised the standard deduction for taxpayers. One of the consequences of this is that many people will no longer be itemizing their deductions, including their church contributions.

But my financial advisor recently told me about a way that anyone over the age of 70-1/2 who has an IRA can contribute to their church and still lower their taxable income. Over the age of 70 1/2, persons with IRA's are required to take what is called a "Required Minimum Distribution" (RMD). If you have that RMD sent to you, you will have to pay income taxes on it. Many people will be in the 20% tax bracket. If your RMD is, say, \$3,000, then you will have to pay \$600 in federal income tax (plus state taxes) on your RMD.

However, if you have your investment company donate your RMD directly to your church, then you do not have to pay income tax on it -- saving yourself (in my above example) \$600.


A person who gives \$50 a week to church gives a total of \$3,000 over 50 weeks. The only difference would be that when the ushers pass the offering plate down the pew, the person over the age of 70-1/2 who gave that one-time \$3,000 RMD to their church will just smile and pass the offering plate on to the next worshiper. The church gets the same amount of money, and the donor saves \$600 on their income tax.
