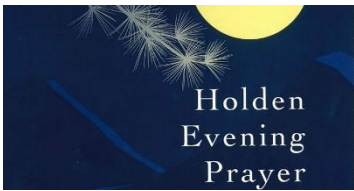


You are invited to join us, *Wednesday, February 14th at 7:00 p.m.*, for Ash Wednesday service which will include imposition of ashes.

Sign-up sheets may be found on the bulletin board outside the sanctuary. Soup, meat/cheese, bread, and fruit/veggies. . . take your pick ☺



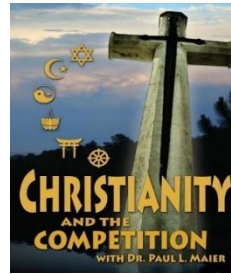
We will use the beautiful **Holden Evening Prayer** for our Lenten worship services:

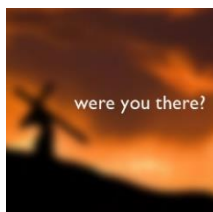


GARAGE SALE

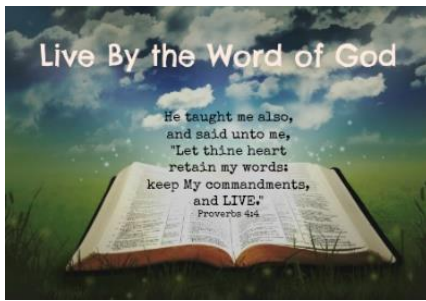
