


Thanks to each of you who submitted names in our ongoing search for our settled pastor. These will be forwarded

Our new MultiGen+ Bible Study is full of good discussion. *Christianity and The Competition* looks at sacred and secular sources to establish the credentials of Christianity.



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Rev. James W. Rehley, 85, of Corvallis, Oregon was called to his eternal rest on Friday, February 9, 2018. He was born April 2, 1932, in Palmer, Massachusetts. He served in the US Air Force as a navigator from 1951-1957.

Pastor Rehley was ordained July 7, 1963, and his first call was to serve the tri-parish Messiah/Zion/Redeemer in Redfield/ Rockham/Doland in South Dakota from 1963-70. Pastor Rehley moved to the Northwest District to serve Grace in Longview, Washington from 1970-79 and Zion in Corvallis, Oregon from 1979-97. He went on emeritus status in 1997. Continuing in service to our Lord in "retirement," he served many vacancies in Oregon, including: Trinity in Bend, Faith in La Pine, Emmaus in Redmond, Christ in Coos Bay, St. James in Myrtle Point, St. Johns in Sutherlin, and Bethel in Sweet Home. He retired again in 2017. He also served as a pastoral conference treasurer, LWML Counselor, Circuit Counselor from 1991-97, and again Circuit Visitor 2015-2018.

Pastor Rehley is survived by his wife of 57 years, Marilynn; siblings Jean Robinson, Ann Chamberlain, and Robert; children Paul, John (Cheryl), Ruth (Chris), Peter (Lucia), and Mark (Melissa); five grandchildren, and two greatgrandchildren.

Pastor Rehley's memorial service will be Saturday, March 17, at 11 a.m., at Zion Lutheran Church, <u>2745 NW Harrison Blvd.</u>, <u>Corvallis, OR 97330</u>-5207.
