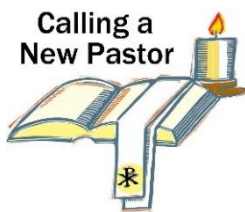

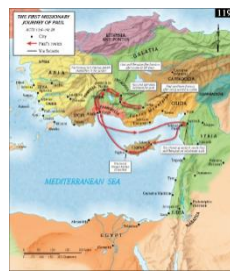

### Giving Garden News

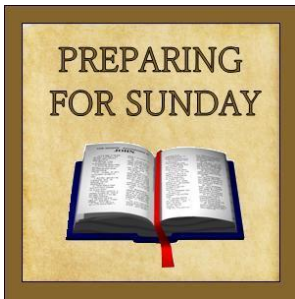

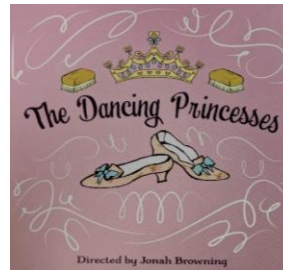
