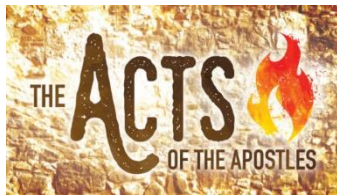


This week's reading from Acts:

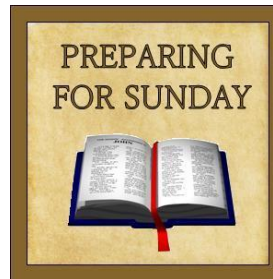
Our MultiGen+ Bible Study will study Chapters 9 and 10 of Acts on Sunday, July 1st.

HOMELESS STUDENT BACKPACK PROJECT

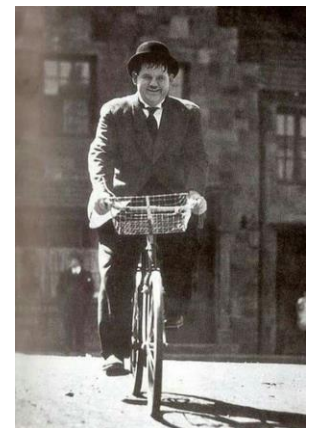
