Saul's murderous thoughts were put to rout.

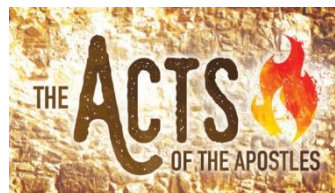
The heart grows still when I am heard,

This warm weather has certainly helped things grow and grow and grow! The next work day is Tuesday, August 6th from 8:30-10:30 a.m.

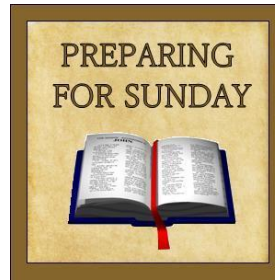


Everyone is invited to volunteer in our Giving Garden. Bring sunscreen, water, and a hat and plan on having some fun!

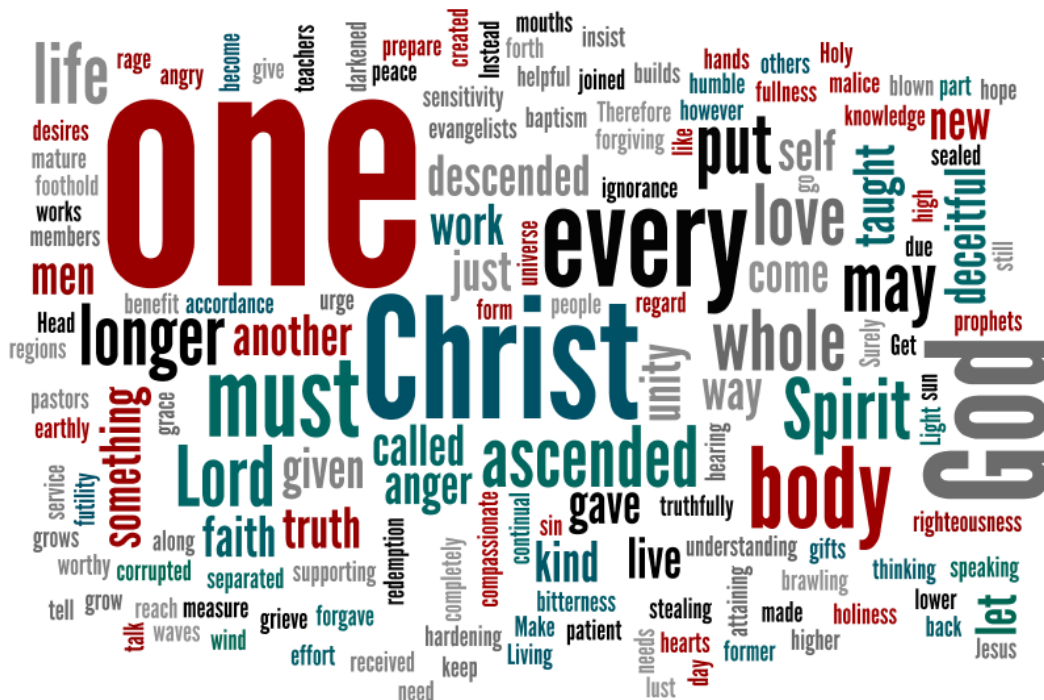
HOMELESS STUDENT BACKPACK PROJECT
