In the last Shepherd Weekly and on Sunday I talked about using our tongue. One last

comment on using our tongue. This comes from Paul in Colossians 4:

"Continue steadfastly in prayer, being watchful in it with thanksgiving. At the same time, pray also for us, that God may open to us a door for the word, to declare the mystery of Christ, on account of which I am in prison- that I may make it clear, which is how I ought to speak.

Walk in wisdom toward outsiders, making the best use of the time. Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you ought to answer each person."

- Make good use of your time.

- Speak about the great mystery and hope we have in Jesus Christ.

- Make sure your speech to those outside of the faith reflects the hope and purpose you have in Jesus Christ.

- Pray, pray, pray. If you live out the above points then people will react to you, so pray for God's wisdom to speak the truth and love of Jesus Christ in ways that make sense to your audience.
