# SHALOM!

We are coming to the end of the Lectionary and church calendar. We are entering into

the Lectionary Series C and will focus on the Gospel of Luke. The creators of the Lectionary are focusing our attention these last two Sundays on how to understand the age we live in, the end times, and the return of Jesus. Jesus is going to ask of you to trust that He is in control, that we should always be aware of who is vying for our allegiance, and to stand firm in Him as His plan to redeem the world moves forward to completion. We can ask the question, "who is in charge of our future?" If you can answer that question then you can align your life with whatever you discover. If you want to do some reading on how best to understand the age we live in, and our future, start with Jesus' teachings in the Gospels on the end times. Jesus saw himself as the messiah proclaimed by the prophets and that He was inaugurating God's great plan through his ministry, death and resurrection, and final return. Next I would check out some of the most commonly selected texts from the Prophets about the coming messiah to get a bigger picture of the hope we have in Jesus. Then read Revelation. Read Revelation with the idea of giving hope to a struggling people and focus on the wrapping up of God's plan and the hope and perspective it gives. Peace.
