### Congregational Meeting



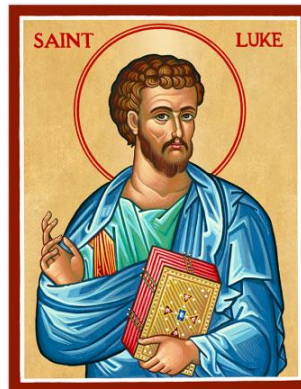

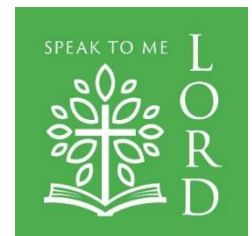

## THRIVENT ANNUAL PLANNING MEETING

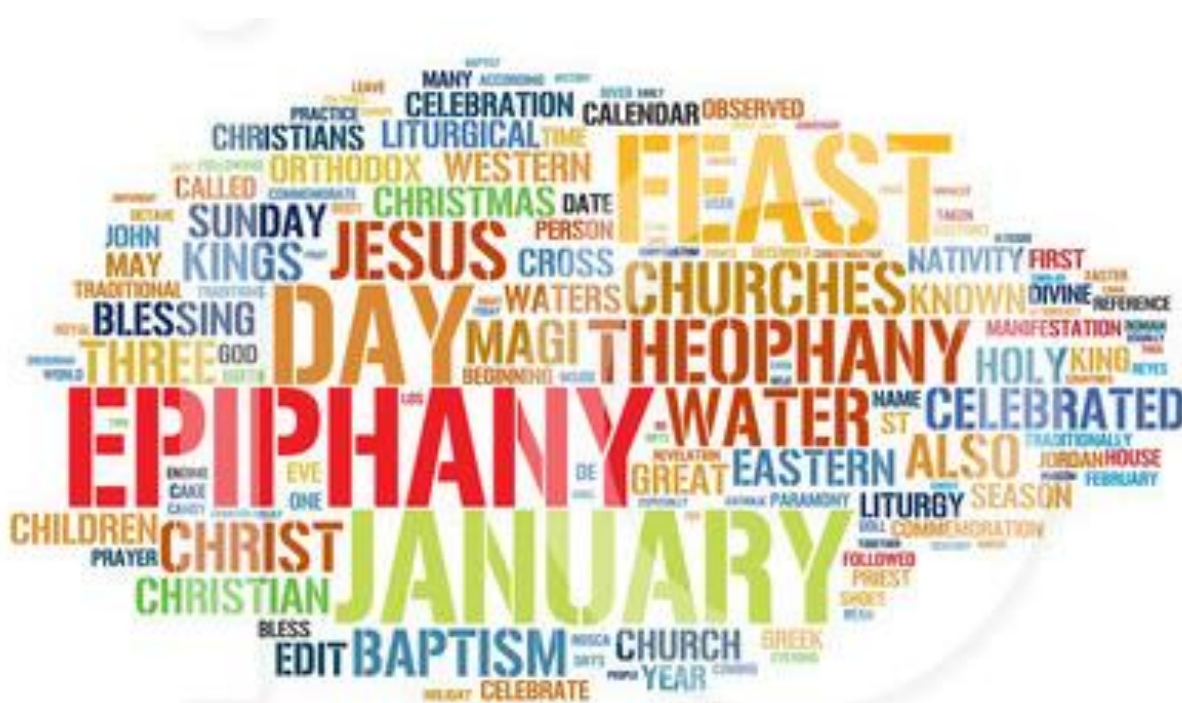
