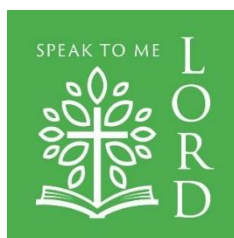

At this meeting we will review the results of Thrivent Choice Dollar Allocations for 2018 and discuss and decide upon the allocations for 2019. Corvallis Repertory Singers will perform Haydn's Creation

The Creation, one of Franz Josef Haydn's most enduring and beloved works, will be presented by the Corvallis Repertory Singers on **Sunday, February 10th at 3:00 p.m.** at Corvallis' First United Methodist Church, 1165 NW Monroe Ave. The Repertory Singers' performance on Sunday marks the 300th anniversary of that first public performance.

Tickets are available at various Corvallis and Albany business locations, online at www.repsing.org; or by mailing [form](#) to PO Box 121, Corvallis, OR 97339. If seats are available, high school and college students are admitted free with student ID; younger students are free when accompanied by a ticketed adult. Ticket outlets include Grass Roots Books, Troubadour Music Center, and Susan's Garden & Coffee Shop (formerly Schmidt's Garden Center) in Corvallis; and Sid Stevens Jewelers in Albany.

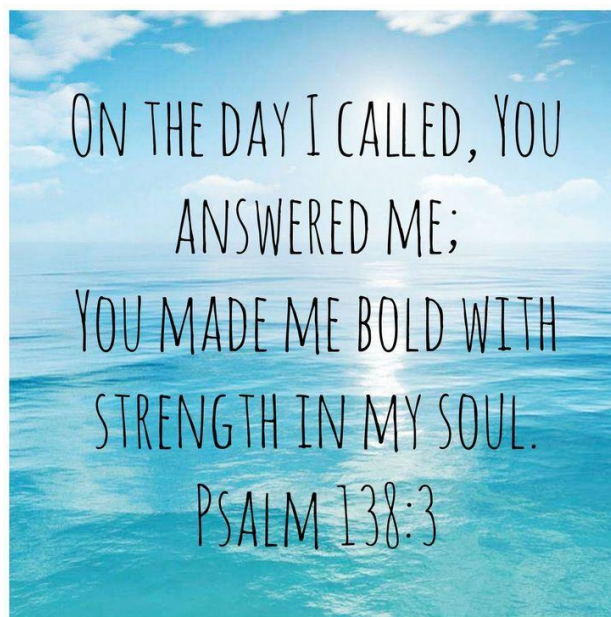
It's the first time the Repertory Singers have tackled this monumental oratorio, which portrays the six days of God's creation, beginning with a roiling orchestral portrait of Chaos and ending with the birth of a fresh and verdant new world. In between, Haydn's music evokes lush meadows and crystal springs, soaring eagles and tuneful nightingales, whales and

"finny tribes," tigers and cows and sheep, even insects and worms.

"The writing is brilliant," said Repertory Singers conductor Steven Zielke. "Not only the most famous passage, 'Let there be light'—that startling fortissimo C-major chord right at the beginning—but also the depiction of lightning, storms, flood, hail, light, and flaky snow. I love the orchestra rolling like the waves below the baritone singing about the foaming billows."

Zielke is the artistic director of the Corvallis Repertory Singers and the Patricia Valian Reser Professor of Music at Oregon State University. "Haydn must have had tremendous fun putting these sounds in the orchestra," Zielke said, "knowing the joy it would give the listener."

EDITOR'S NOTE: Shepherd of the Valley's own Peter Klammer will be singing in this amazing performance. Take some time on Saturday afternoon to go and listen to some great music!
