Built on the Rock, the church shall stand even when steeples are falling...

The Notre Dame served its purpose long ago. When it burned down it was a monument to architecture, creativity, history, and humanity. The church has never been and never will be the buildings in which Christ's body uses to meet for the purpose of knowing God and each other and accomplishing her mission. Buildings mean something but what they mean serves to get people to God's Word to transform their lives through the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

There is a Lutheran church in Hillsboro who long ago sold their traditional church

property in downtown and moved to a new location. They worshipped in a multipurpose gym and their ministry grew but it wasn't the gym that did that. They were focused on reaching people and the building served well her multiple needs. Many people wouldn't have crossed the doors of a historic church building but a gym is a known and accepted structure by just about everyone. What I want to illustrate through the gym is that the building got out of the way by being an accepted structure by the dominant culture. Notre Dame and other historical building styles have a harder time doing that. It can happen, and does happen but when it comes to reaching the lost and those who haven't been part of the historic church architecture can be an issue. It can also be an issue inside the church because it can replace, in the hearts of men and women, the true purpose of the church's property. The church is struggling right now because the members wanted long-time а more traditional sanctuary, they got it, but many non-historic members would rather focus their dollars on human related ministry purposes. The non-historic members were promised a certain amount of money for ministry expansions but those dollars have not been delivered because those dollars were needed for unforeseen building costs. Trappings of the past are getting in the way of the church's mission and those who want to be about ministry.

The lesson I take from Notre Dame and the church in Hillsboro is to always keep focused on getting people to God's Word, in any kind of building, so all can hear God's promise, "I know My own, My own know Me, you, not the world, My face shall see; My peace I leave with you. Amen."

Women on Wednesdays 1st and 3rd Wednesdays 10:00 – 11:30 a.m. SVLC Large Classroom


